

## *Something special for Lent*

Many of our users will be familiar with the traditional Catholic devotion known as the Stations of the Cross, a series of meditations on scenes from the Passion of Jesus, from his sentencing at the hands of Pilate to the laying of his body in the tomb.

There are fourteen standard stations, but some variations from this form exist, including one more closely following the scriptures, approved by Pope Benedict in 2007.

During Lent, in addition to the daily *Pray-as-you-go*, we offer a series of ten scripture-based meditations in the tradition of the Stations of the Cross.
